Tech Tips: What OpenDNS is and why you should use it

TECH TIPS

DNS servers are one of the underlying technologies that allow the Internet to function in an easy to use manner. For example, translating the friendlier "google.com" into its IP address: 72.14.207.99. While this is essential to the Internet, it is vulnerable to both security and performance problems.

Instead of using the DNS servers provided by your ISP, which are often underpowered, overworked and unpatched, try OpenDNS. It is an easy-to-implement solution for these kinds of problems. In addition to being free, it features the advantage of being more reliable, faster, safer and smarter than other DNS servers.

Use it however makes sense for you and your organization. You can merely point to their servers and be done, or you can sign up for an account that will also allow you to take advantage of all of the available features.
